Clear channels of communication with dental providers, families and ESHC staff

Trained and engaged ESHC staff

Reliable compliance with all recommended visits

Patient-centered visits through integration with dental provider

Interventions (LOR #)

Test care team tracking

Update dental provider list

Train how/when/where to document care team

Incorporate Brush, Book, Bed materials into current workflow

Meet with dental director and dental team to improve internal referral process

Leverage all visit types to check dental status

Standard communication on importance of regular dental visits and a dental home

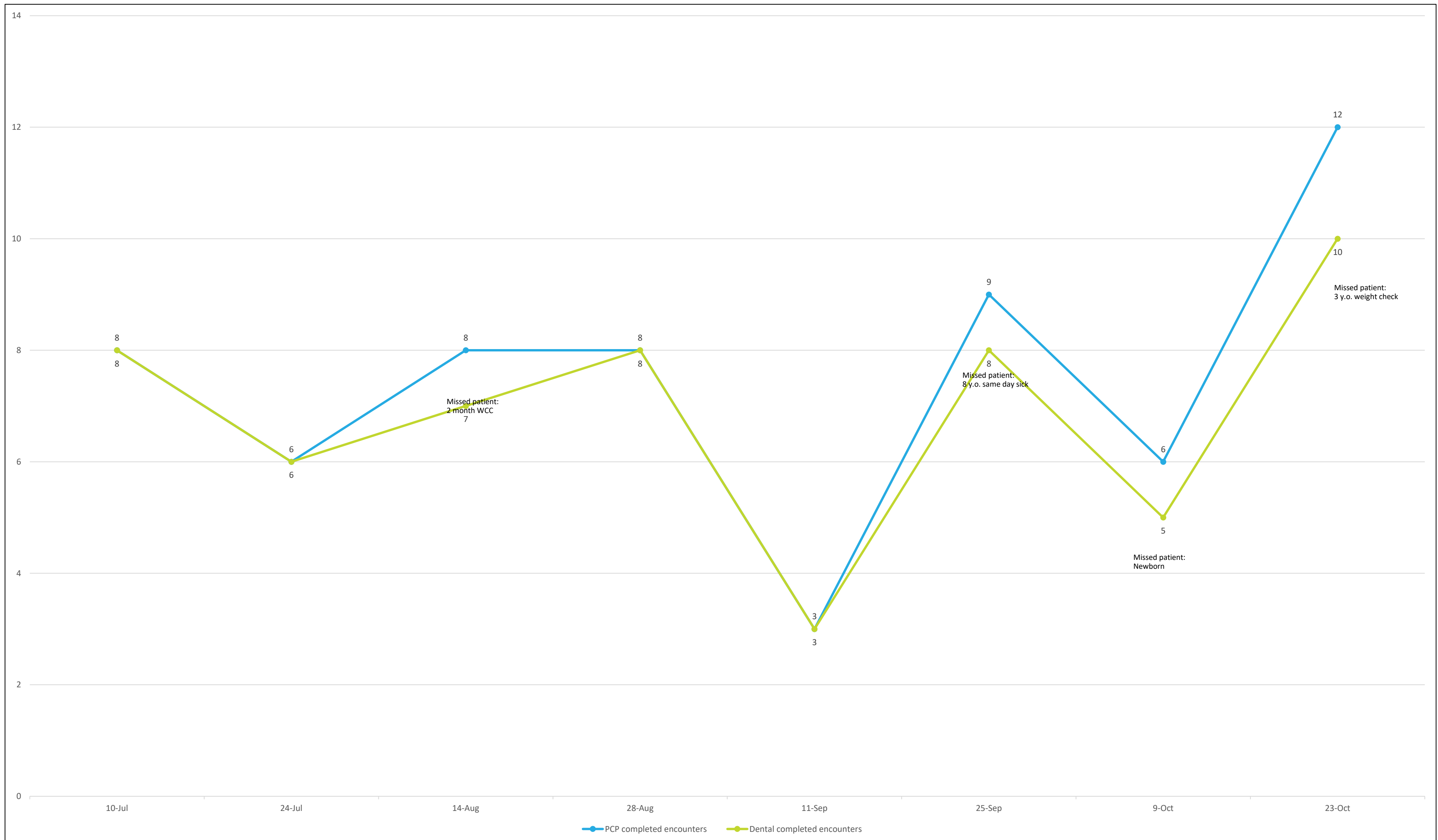

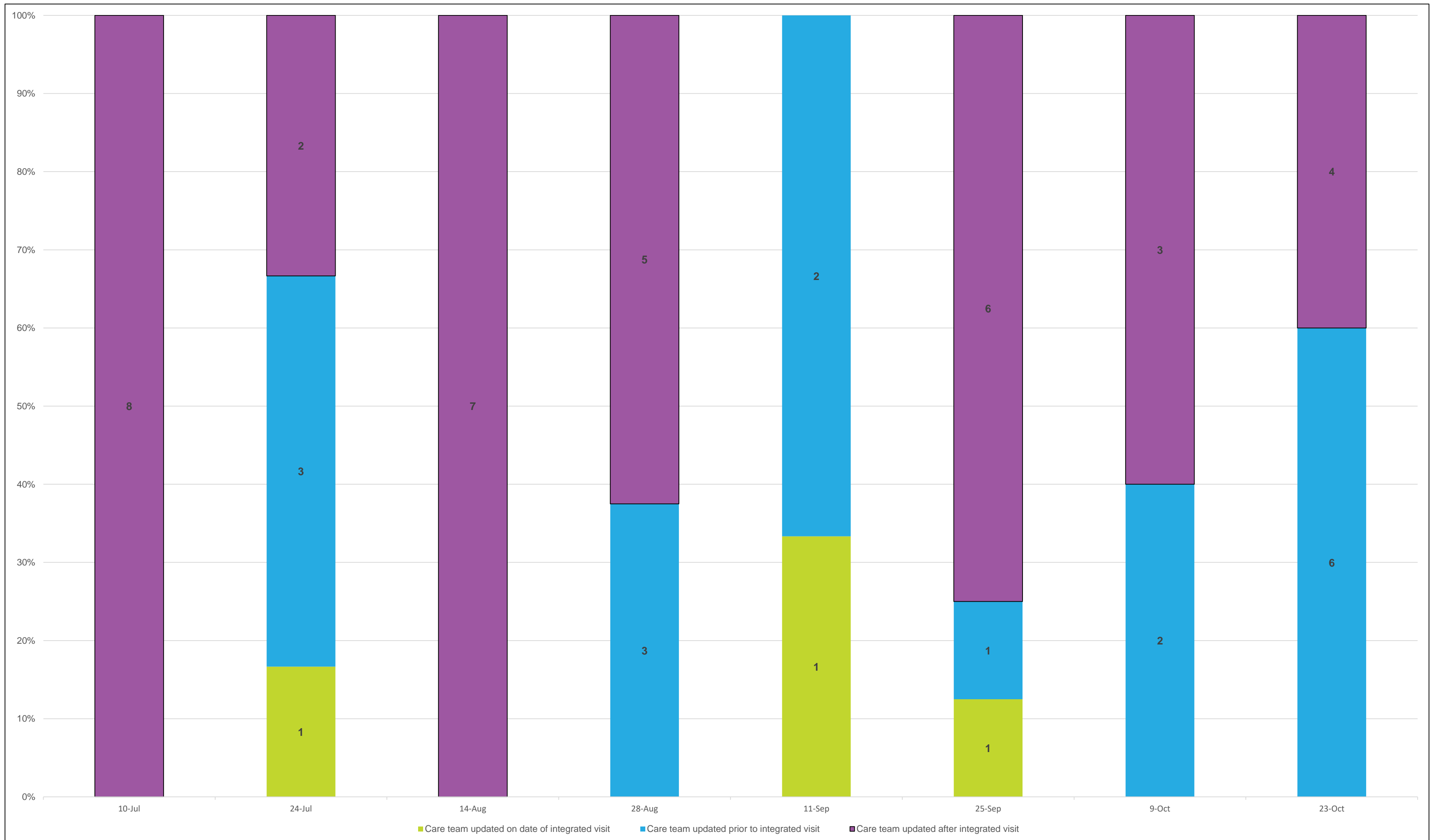

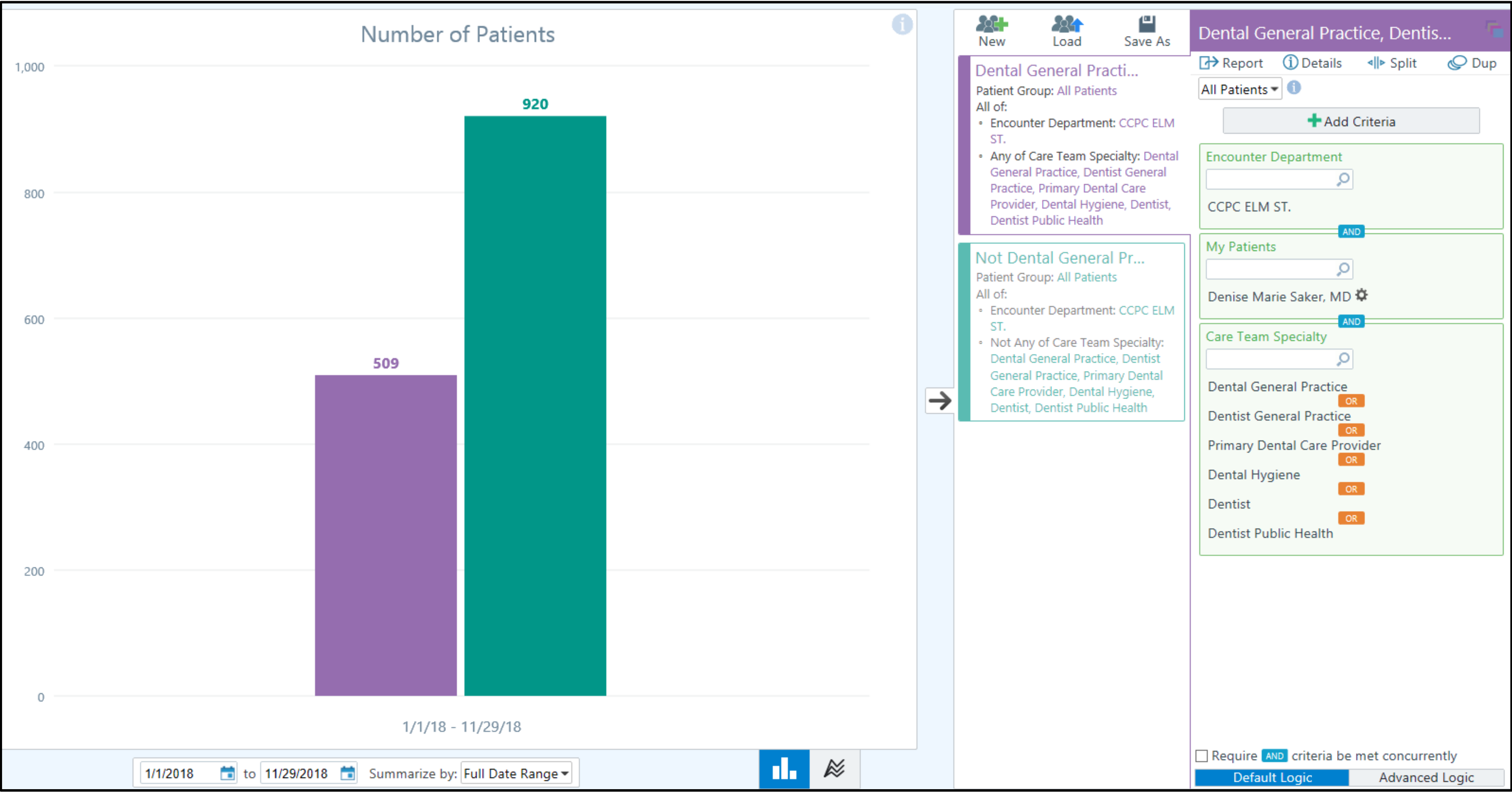
