




### BACKGROUND






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


### SUPPLEMENTAL DATA



Since February 2019, the following data have been manually collected during Well Child Visits at Price Hill Clinic:


Total Number of Children Price Hill Clinic Assessed for Preschool Interest	170
Number Already Enrolled	39 (23%)
Number Expressing Interest in Services	135 (79%)
Number of Referral Forms Completed	16



## In partnership and collaboration with 4C for Children, we have confirmed the following:

Number of Families Connected to Price Hill Clinic Seeking Care	21
Total Number Children from these Families Needing Care	24
Number of Referrals Given for these 21 Families	91
Number of Families Finding Care	18*

<sup>\*</sup>Of these 18 families finding care, 6 chose highly rated Step Up to Quality child care programs
